Associate Professor (Dr) Gokula studied medicine at Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) and pursued his 5-year specialist training under the Royal Australian and New Zealand College Of Radiologists (RANZCR) Consultant Radiation Oncologist training programme. During this time he has worked at **National University Hospital** and **Tan Tock Seng Hospital** in Singapore and **William Buckland Radiotherapy Centre, Alfred Health**, Melbourne. He was awarded the Fellowship in Radiation Oncology (FRANZCR) by RANZCR in 2013. He currently practice at **AMDI, Universiti Sains Malaysia** and also **Penang Adventist Hospital**.

His primary interest is brachytherapy for liver and tongue. Prof Gokula has published in international citation indexed journals and vastly contributed to the field of Radiation Oncology/Brachytherapy. The **HyBIRT** radiotherapy technique for tongue cancer is a novel treatment method developed by AMDI-USM team lead by Prof Gokula and as the first author presented the findings at as a proffered paper at ESTRO 2023.
